If you're wondering how to change your religion in Conan Exiles, then you're in the right place. In reality it is possible to convert or worship more than one god in the game for free, but only if you talk to the right people. In this guide we will take you through how to change your religion in Conan Exiles. How to change your Religion in Exile of Conan
When you are beginning, the game lets you choose a religion out of 4 that are available. These religions are Crom, Set, Mitra and Yog. If you decide to change this selection or even worship all 3 (the Chromium cannot be converted as it is a god who does not require any worship), you can do so without spending any point of knowledge if you are able to find the priest or priestess of the designated religion you are trying to learn. © Funcom Mek-kamoses can show you how to change your religion in Acolyte of Set. The God of Set rules snakes and poison. To get his favor, you must prove that you have committed a human sacrifice by offering his altar a human heart. Set will then give you powers such as poison resistance and sacred ability to transform snakes into arrows. If you travel to Q:4 of the map (see map below), you will find Mek-kamoses near a giant temple surrounded by poisonous spiders. Here you can ask him to teach you the ways of Set. © Funcom Jamila the Queen Pirate can show you how to change your religion toby Mitra. Mitra is the Goddess of law and justice, but the means in which his followers convert others can be considered a little too enthusiastic. To obtain his favor, you will have to bless the bodies of your enemies killed with the Mitrean Ankh. This will provide you with the essence of their soul that you can bring back as a gift to its altar. It provides worshippers with a number of sacred objects. To begin practicing Mitra, you can find Jamila hanging out near a cliff overlooking a pirate ship in V:6 of the map Conan Exiles (see map below.) Where to learn the Acolyte of Yog
© Funcom Niuru Cannibal can teach you how to change your religion to Acolyte of Yog, who is the God of cannibals. To get the good graces of Yog, you will have to bring a piece of human flesh immaculate to one of his alters. To recover meat, you must use a cloister and then cook in the pit of the temple of Yog. This ritual will please Yog who will then provide faithful followers with enchanted armor and weapons. To follow the path of Yog, you will have to go to N:12 of the map of Conan Exiles (see map below) to find Nunu. © Funcom Conan Exiles is an open-world survival game still in Early Access. Additional content is expected to come out for the game, including other gods and gods. When they do, we will be sure to update this article with the positions for each. Until then, many players have discovered that it is extremely useful to worship all 3Gods/Goddesses because they offer access to unique recipes, armor and weapons. Crom looks at the world from his mountaintop, but he does not respond to prayers and will not receive any worship. If you choose Crom as your god at the beginning of the game, you do not get the knowledge of an acolyte, so it is the god to choose if you do not want to get involved in the religious system in Conan Exiles. Derketo [edit] The "Dia of fertility, death and lust". - Derketo, the goddess of lust, death and fertility, which is Puttanelia and Queen Sable. Jhebbal Sag[edit | edit source] The "God of animals, nature and wild", and the Lord of all animals and beasts, including men. [2] Mitra [edit] The God of Law and Justice. Mitra, chosen god of the Iborians, claims to be a god of law and justice, but his zealous followers consume themselves by expanding his religion at the expense of all others. The followers of Mitra are given the opportunity to create sacred statues, clothing, healers and weapons – includingsymbol of the Phoenix. Set [edit] The God of snakes and sacrifice. Put on, the Old Serpent, glories in the ritual sacrifice of humans at the top of his bloody altars. The followers of Set are granted powers that align with their god, protection from Poison and the ability to transform the Snakes into Arrows. Ymir[edit] The God of snow, storm and war. - Nordheim adores Ymir, the Frost giant, Lord of the Storm and War, who lives (according to legend), in Valhalla, his castle far north of Vanaheim. According to the shamans of Nordheim, the souls of warriors who fall into battle go to Valhalla to feast and fight forever. This belief makes the Nordheim warriors terribly fierce in battle, and often fight without regard for their safety. Yog[edit | edit source] The "God of the Cannibals" - Yog, the Lord of the Empirical Abdoeds, demands that his followers consume flesh that has been purified ritually. This means the flesh of other human beings, and in return, Yog gives his followers blessing them with weapons and weapons. Zath[edit] Earn favor with gods[edit] The knowledge given following the other gods will give some advantages. Depending on the chosen religion, an altar can be built as soon as possible, providing unique recipes. The favorite is earned in various ways. Each altar provides a special recipe that can be used to collect human bodies after their defeat. Derketo - Use Derketo's kiss to collect unfinished Sliver. Jhebbal Sag -Letter of Blood for the collection of the Holy Blood. Mitra - Use the Mitraen Ankh to collect Lingering Essence. Set - Use the Setite ritual knife to collect human hearts. Ymir - Use the Hoar-Frost Hatchet to collect ice fragments. Yog - Use Yog Cleaver to collect unstained human flesh. Zath - Use the ritual dagger Zathite to collect the blood purified by poison. Religion Teachers[edit] All religions can be learned during the game if you talk to the correct coach for specific religion. For example, if you want to learn the Set religion then you need to find the Trainer Set. All trainers can be found worldwide. Moreover, it costs 50 points to learn a religion from within the Feats menu unless it was learned during character creation, making religious trainers the effective way to learn other religions. Muriela and Mek-kamoses also teach the cult hemoths of Mitra and By Set respectively. Notes[edit | edit source] The gods are jealous beings and do not allow their respective altars to be placed too close to each other, so that it may be necessary to defend a large area when worshipping multiple gods. Developers said they didn't plan new gods after Jhebbal Sag. If they were added, the futures based on those found in the data files are Bel god of thieves, and possibly Gullah the god Gorilla (based on the statues of god gorilla in play, like the statue of Hanuman, the God Ape, in the Newbie oasisTrivia[edit | edit source] Crom is often cited by Conan in the films Conan the Barbarian and Conan the Destroyer. Set religion is an important plot point in the film Conan the Barbarian (1982). However, it is usually referred to as "Snake Cult" and the word Set is only said twice in the movie. "Yog" is Howard's nod to his good friend Lovecraft work.
