

The Content Outline displays Major Content Areas and Job Tasks being tested, along with their respective percentages and breakdowns into individual tasks. For instance, "Footings and Foundations" might account for 16% of the exam content, with related job tasks listed beneath. You can download and print the outline for study purposes by clicking the Print button on the top-right of the exam listing. When ready to register, click the green "Register" button to proceed to the ICC Store for purchase. In cases where exams are only offered on Saturdays, candidates with religious objections can request alternative test dates in writing, supported by official documentation from their religious advisor. The International Code Council's Contractor/Trades examination program offers independent testing for contractors and trades professionals, providing licensing agencies with information on qualified individuals. Participation does not guarantee a license, but it serves as an appraisal of competency in the construction field. To ensure accuracy, candidates must review Exam Information Bulletins and exam-specific content outlines before registering. For those seeking certification or licensing relevant to their job, the Code Council's credentialing program is considered prestigious and widely recognized globally. The California Certification Program meets specific state requirements and is deemed substantially equivalent to Code Council certifications.
