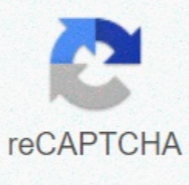

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SET® is a tricky and simple pattern recognition card game, with mathematical subpinning complexes. Each SET card has the following variants: Symbol: Oval, squiggle or diamondColor: Red, green or purple symbols Shade: Strip, solid or outlined symbolsNumber: One, two or three symbols The idea is to put 12 cards face up, and then match three cards to make a SET. A SET includes three cards with common features: shape, color, shadow or number of symbols. However, three completely different cards can also include a SET -- their common feature being that they have nothing in common. For example, if a card has a solid red oval, another card has two striped green diamonds and a third has three purple squiggles outlined, it is considered a SET. So for each variable, all cards must be equal or all different to make a SET. Just remember the "Magic Rule" from the creators of the game: "If two are... and one is not, then it is not a SET" [source: SET Game]. SET was invented in 1974 when Marsha Jean Falco, a geneticist of the population, drew symbols on cards representing genetic combinations so that he can better view the models in his data. The cards made it easier to search for Falco, but also to discover all possible combinations of symbols proved fun. Falco introduced the cards to his friends and family, which encouraged her to market it as a game. In 1990, SET went on sale at US retailers and the game became a world phenomenon, making this every man chess a game for age [source: SET Game]. Hundreds of thousands of SET games have been sold since its debut. There are SET tournaments that draw dozens of players, ranging from 6 to senior Citizen, and the New York Times publishes an online multiplayer version every day. The bread plate should be placed above and to the left of the dinner and the salad plate. The butter knife can be positioned horizontally on the bread plate. The dinner fork goes to the left of the dinner plate and the salad fork goes to the left of the dinner fork. Put the knife to the right of the dinner plate and then set the spoon to the right of the knife. The dessert spoon should be positioned horizontally above the dinner plate. White and red wine glasses go in the upper right corner or in the room. The glass of water should be closer to the guest (hopefully they drink more water than wine), and the red fiberglass goes right behind the white fiberglass. There are several factors that contribute to gas prices that increase and fall. However it may seem like a conspiracy to ruin your day, the price of tomorrow's domain gas will depend on everything from purchases of crude oil, cost refining, marketing, taxes and limits established by the organization of oil exporting countries (OPEC). Here is a look at some of the key determinants of state gas prices in detail. This is the most important factor, and it is the reason why gas retail prices vary so much. This cartel organization lays down limits on how much oil each of its Member States can sell, exerting a massive influence on prices. Sometimes geopolitical events, natural disasters and oil spills can affect the price of gas by interrupting the flow of crude oil. This is why prices have increased in response to instability in the Middle East, Venezuela and parts of Africa - all involved in oil production. Hurricane Katrina and the Gulf Coast BP oil spill disaster also affected prices. Of course, the US dollar exchange rate also makes a difference. Since the value drops from other major currencies, the price of oil increases. The speculation of the commodity market is another factor. When financial speculators bet on the price of oil going up or down, it eventually contributes to gas price fluctuations to the pump. In general, refiners earn about 20 cents for each oil gallon thatNot all the gas is the same, of course. And each different type is produced through a different process of refining. In the United States, this also applies to seasonal gas types required by government regulations. For summer months, for example, refineries mix some additives with oil during production, such as ethanol. These are these. the total cost, which you will end up paying to the pump. However, the winter artificial gas tends to cost less for production, often bringing savings that are transferred to you as consumers. Federal, state and local taxes apply to each tax gallon. And while the federal excise remained constant from 1993 to 13.4 cents per gallon, other taxes tend to vary. These include state taxes on gasoline and local and state taxes on sales, among others. To get an idea of how state taxes vary, we take 2015 as an example. Although the average state tax was 24.17 cents per gallon, some states have been significantly more or less. California and Pennsylvania charged 41.06 and 41.80 cents respectively, while Georgia charged only 8 cents. Getting oil from source to refinery and gas from refinery to your local dealer involves a great deal of transport. The more gas you need to travel, the more transport costs. When the local gas station is actually owned and operated by the refinery, however, these tend to be a little lower. Other costs related to the distribution and marketing of refined petrol include wages and benefits, equipment, rental costs and insurance. And these may vary considerably from one country to another, leading to fluctuations in gas prices from one State to another. There is also the question of competition. When two competing petrol stations are located a short distance from each other, competition between the two will tend to decrease prices. In view of all other factors, the local gas station still has to make a profit. So also this will contribute to the price. Most retailers earn 14 cents for each sold gallon. sold.

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
