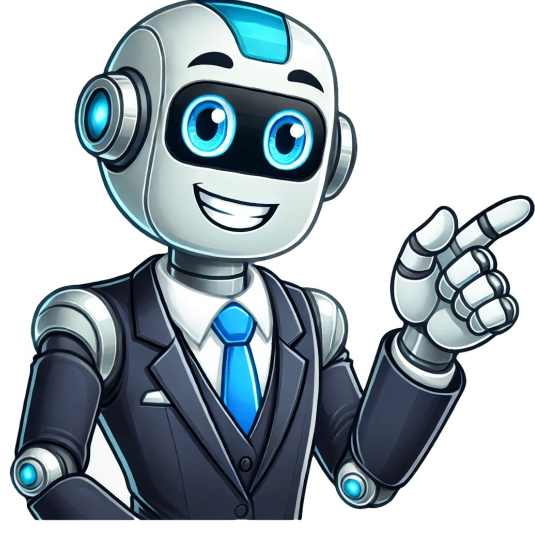

B2 is the most demanded proficiency level for job positions requiring the daily active use of language. Compared to the alternative English language assessment frameworks, it is similar to IELTS level 5-6 or TOEFL scores 87-109. The CEFR Common Reference levels are fully defined in a structured set of illustrative 'can-do' descriptors for many different categories. The main descriptors for the B2 level also include these 'can-do' statements: Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialisation. Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party.
