Dr. Peoples also has co-authored ESSENTIALS OF CULTURAL ANTHROPOLOGY and INTRODUCTION TO CULTURAL ANTHROPOLOGY. He has published most of the results of a comparative analysis of political evolution in Micronesia. He also is the co-author of ESSENTIALS OF CULTURAL ANTHROPOLOGY and INTRODUCTION TO CULTURAL ANTHROPOLOGY. He has also taught in the anthropology departments of the University of California at Davis and the University of Tulsa. Since becoming Director of East Asian Studies in 2004, Dr. Peoples has journeyed to Korea and Japan for seminars and workshops. His first book, ISLAND IN TRUST (1985), summarized the results of this field research. He recently published a chapter, translated into Chinese, in a book used in cultural anthropology courses in the People's Republic of China.
