To start using Gmail, you need to make a Google account first. Using your username and password, you can access Gmail along with other Google services like YouTube, Google Play, and Google Drive. If you are setting up a new Gmail account for the first time, it is essential that you log out of your current account before creating a new one. Check out how to log out from Gmail. From your device, go to the Google Account sign in page and click on Create account. You can choose whether your account will be used for: Personal use Child Work or business. Follow the steps provided on the screen to set up your account. A tip to consider is that if you want to use Gmail for work, a Google Workspace account might be more suitable than a personal account. With this type of account, you get extra storage space and professional-looking email addresses along with additional features. If your chosen username is already in use or very similar to an existing one, you will not be able to create a new Gmail address. This can happen if someone else has used the same username in the past but deleted it. Some usernames might also be reserved by Google to prevent spam and abuse. Moreover, if someone has created a fake Gmail account to impersonate your identity, there is no way for Gmail to resolve this issue through mediation.
