## Star wars ahsoka cast

Star Wars fans have been hoping to see Ezra Bridger and Grand Admiral Thrawn be brought into live-action ever since witnessing their exploits in Star Wars Rebels, with the possibility of the characters having been cast seeming greater than ever, due to Star Wars: Ahsoka actor Rosario Dawson sharing casting news on her Instagram. Dawson shared a screenshot of a story about Mena Massoud and Lars Mikkelsen playing Ezra and Thrawn, respectively, to her Instagram story, understandably leading many to assume this was further evidence that such casting has already occurred. However, no official outlets or trades have announced such casting decisions, with it being possible that she merely came across the news and took it as fact instead of speculation.As seen in the below screenshot, Dawson shared a report about the casting, while adding, "Yassss the best news ever! I need my BIPOC representation in [Star Wars]. Can't wait to see my BBs thrive in Ahsoka as my fav characters in the universe!" Luckily, Rebels revived the character to serve as the foil to Ezra and the rest of the Ghost's crew, with the Rebels series finale ending on a cliffhanger that somewhat left the fate of the duo unresolved.When audiences saw Dawson debut as Ahsoka in Season 2 of The Mandalorian, speculation began about when other characters from animation could be heading to live-action, with the announcement of Star Wars: Ahsoka leading many to assume that series could see the search for Ezra and Thrawn, as teased both in Mandalorian and the Rebels finale. Mikkelsen's casting would make him yet another actor who voiced a character and then played them in live-action, with Massoud himself adding speculation to the Ezra casting earlier this year when he shared a photo of himself with the caption, "Hey, just so you know, when I escape I won't hurt any of you," which Rebels fans recognized as a line Ezra said in the series.0commentsStay tuned for details on official Star Wars casting updates.Are you hoping this confirms the casting decisions? According to The Hollywood Reporter, Lucasfilm is looking to cast someone in the role of the Mandalorian Warrior turned rebel. Ahsoka Tano isn't the only animated Star Wars character making the jump to live-action. In a recent article from The Hollywood Reporter about the animated Marvel Series What If...? it was reported that Lucasfilm was looking for an actress to portray Mandalorian Warrior turned rebel Sabine Wren for the upcoming live-action Disney Plus series Star Wars: Ahsoka. While the article is primarily focused on Brad Winderbaum, the head of streaming, television, and animation at Marvel Studios, it also mentions the casting rumors. Star Wars: Ahsoka is set to be a spin-off of the incredibly popular Disney Plus series The Mandalorian, the first live-action Star Wars series to premiere on streaming giant. While plot details are scarce at the moment, the series will follow Anakin Skywalker's former padawan Ahsoka Tano, portrayed by actress Rosario Dawson, who first played the role in the second season of The Mandalorian. However, like Sabine, Ahsoka's first appearance was as an animated character in the series Star Wars: The Clone Wars, created by The Mandalorian co-creator Dave Filoni. Sabine first appeared in the animated series Star Wars: Rebels. The series, also created by Filoni, was in many ways a continuation of The Clone Wars and followed some of the same characters, including Ahsoka. Voiced by The Good Place actress Tiya Sircar, Sabine was featured prominently in all four seasons of Star Wars: Rebels, which told the story of the early days and the formation of the rebel alliance. In the series, Sabine is a young Mandalorian Warrior who left her homeworld after it was taken over by the Empire. She is portrayed as a fierce warrior, a loyal ally, and a talented artist. She's also one of the few characters in Star Wars to wield the infamous Darksaber, which was featured heavily in both animated series and The Mandalorian season 2. While nothing is set in stone at the moment, it makes sense that Sabine would appear in the Ahsoka series. At the end of Star Wars: Rebels Sabine is seen teaming up with Ahsoka to try and find their friend, Jedi Trainee Ezra Bridger, who disappears along with imperial villain Grand Admiral Thrawn in the series finale. Since Ahsoka outright says in The Mandalorian that she is looking for Thrawn, fans took this as clear confirmation that characters such as Sabine, Thrawn, and Ezra would appear in the Ahsoka series. There have also been casting rumors surrounding these characters, including Aladin star Mena Massoud being rumored to be considered for Ezra. Some fans even speculated that Sabine would appear in The Mandalorian alongside Ahsoka, but sadly that didn't happen. While this news was expected, it's still exciting for any fans of Star Wars: Rebels. Sabine is a great character who would be right at home in the new live-action TV Star Wars universe. There are no casting rumors at the moment, but some fan casting choices for Sabine include Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D star Chloe Bennet and Game of Thrones actress Jessica Henwick, who recently joined the incredible cast of Knives Out 2. Among standalone series like Obi-Wan Kenobi, Lando, and Andor comes a whole range of stories in the post-Return of the Jedi era of The Mandalorian. The Book of Boba Fett, Ahsoka, and Rangers of the Republic will spin out of the existing series, with the latter currently figuring out a new path after firing its former lead Gina Carano. The Boba Fett series will be the first to debut this December following the character's cliffhanger moment in the concluding moments of The Mandalorian Season two finale. Ahsoka will star the iconic The Clone Wars Jedi in her own series, following on from past appearances in The Mandalorian Season two and Star Wars: Rebels. With Rosario Dawson already cast in the lead role, the series is currently casting its side characters in preparation to shoot later this year. AHSOKA REVEALS CASTING DETAILS AND SYNOPSIS Star Wars In a post on his Patreon, popular scooper DanielRPK shared details on the production of the Ahsoka Disney+ series, including a synopsis and the casting of two major roles. The leak reveals the upcoming The Mandalorian spin-off casting for the character of Boka, a 20 to 35-year-old male with a youthful appearance. He is described as being strong-minded and independent with leadership qualities. Lucasfilm is specifically looking for Middle Eastern, African, Pacific Islander, Black, Mixed Ethnicity, or Caribbean actors for the supporting role. Additionally, the post said that the Disney+ production is searching for a 40 to 60-year-old male of any ethnicity to portray Morai. The casting call notes a preference for accents in whoever takes on the volatile and complex role with a shady nature. While unconfirmed, it's likely these two roles have been hidden behind fake names and are for the live-action debuts of Rebels' star Ezra Bridger and villain Grand Admiral Thrawn. Lastly, as is standard for the world of Star Wars, Ahsoka is looking for soldier actors between the ages of 20 to 60 with no preference for ethnicity or gender. These actors will be covered with face masks, likely suggesting these soldiers will wear helmets as Stormtroopers. The Rosario Dawson-led series will take Anakin Skywalker's former Padawan on "the hunt for the evil Grand Admiral Thrawn" as she tries to find "the missing Ezra Bridger." "Ahsoka Tano (Rosario Dawson) is on the hunt for the evil Grand Admiral Thrawn in the hope it will help her locate the missing Ezra Bridger, the young Jedi that disappeared with Thrawn many years ago." An official shooting date for the Disney+ adventure is yet to be set, however, production begins in 2021, likely suggesting a 2022 premiere. The finale of Star Wars: Rebels sent Ahsoka Tano and Mandalorian warrior Sabine on the hunt for Ezra Bridger, who was last shown jumping into hyperspace with the villainous Grand Admiral Thrawn. "The Jedi" episode of The Mandalorian revealed Ahsoka was still very much on the hunt for Ezra and Thrawn when she met up with Din Djarin and Grogu. The two illusive characters' only canon appearances are in the Star Wars: Rebels animated series, meaning this will act as a live-action debut for both. Aladdin star Mena Massoud has recently teased his interest in the role of Ezra, a character he bears a clear resemblance to, thus making him a popular choice among fans. Benedict Cumberbatch has been a fan cast for the live-action Thrawn for some time, however, the actor recently shut down the speculation, revealing he isn't interested in taking on the role. Other popular casting suggestions have included Harry Potter's Jason Issacs and even the character's Rebels voice actor Lars Mikkelsen. Both The Mandalorian and the Marvel Disney+ series' have shown the studio's willingness to cash out for major actors in its blockbuster sagas, so it's likely that top talent will be booked for these key parts. There has been discussion of an animated sequel to Star Wars: Rebels for some time now, however, the plot description of Ahsoka seems to indicate the story will instead take the live-action route. Ahsoka has yet to set an official release date, but with shooting slated to begin this year, a 2022 debut is extremely likely.
