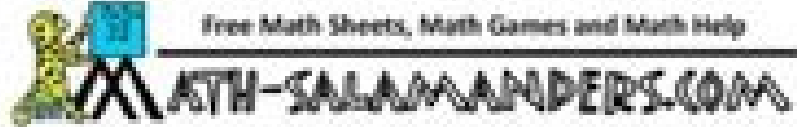

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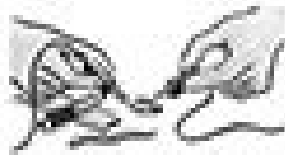
Conducting electricity

Background knowledge

Matter that allows electricity to pass through it easily is called an *electrical conductor*. Electricity passes through a conductor to run on a TV or computer. For example, *Metals can conduct electricity*, but *water* can't better conductor than others. Solutions that have dissolved charged particles in them can also conduct electricity.

Science activity
